

Senate Bill 197

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the DOC to study the facilities where people who commit crimes are kept in Oregon. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.3).

Requires the Department of Corrections to study correctional facilities. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary no later than September 15, 2026.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Corrections shall study correctional facilities. The de-**
5 **partment shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include**
6 **recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly re-**
7 **lated to the judiciary no later than September 15, 2026.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
