

# Senate Bill 2

Sponsored by Senator WEBER, Representative JAVADI

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to DAS to give to a foundation to repair a salvage vessel. (Flesch Readability Score: 74.2).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to the Salvage Chief (LSM380) Foundation for the purpose of repairing and upgrading a salvage vessel.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
5 **ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July**  
6 **1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, to be distributed by grant to the**  
7 **Salvage Chief (LSM380) Foundation, an Oregon public benefit corporation, for the purpose**  
8 **of repairing, upgrading and returning to operation the vessel known as the Salvage Chief,**  
9 **as follows:**

10 (1) **\$1,894,737 for hull repairs;**

11 (2) **\$631,579 for engine and fire pump upgrades; and**

12 (3) **\$473,684 for emergency communications upgrades, United States Coast Guard in-**  
13 **spection and contingency.**

14 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**  
16 **July 1, 2025.**
