SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act directs the OBDD to make and give plaques to schools. The plaques honor Senator Peter Courtney's support of funding seismic safety for schools. (Flesch **Readability Score:** 72.3). [Digest: The Act directs ODE to design and give plaques to schools that have benefited from Sen-

[Digest: The Act alrects ODE to design and give plaques to schools that have benefited from Sen-ator Peter Courtney's support of funding seismic safety for schools. (Flesch Readability Score: 81.1).] Directs the [Department of Education] **Oregon Business Development Department** to [design] **create** and distribute memorial plaques to schools in honor of Senator Peter Courtney's contributions in supporting seismic rehabilitation funding. Directs recipients to display plaques [at the front entrance] in a location that is easily visible to visitors to the school.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "qualifying school" means a building or preman-
5	ufactured structure that is used to provide educational services to children in any grade
6	from kindergarten through grade 12 and that has received a distribution for seismic reha-
7	bilitation from the Education Seismic Fund pursuant to ORS 286A.768.
8	(2) To recognize and honor Senator Peter Courtney's contributions for his role in sup-
9	porting seismic rehabilitation funding for schools in this state, the Oregon Business Devel-
10	opment Department shall create and distribute memorial plaques to schools that have
11	received distributions from the Education Seismic Fund under ORS 286A.768 beginning on
12	or after January 1, 2009, and have completed projects before the effective date of this 2025
13	Act.
14	(3) A qualifying school that receives a memorial plaque shall:
15	(a) Prominently display the plaque so that it is easily viewable by visitors to the school;
16	and
17	(b) Mount the plaque for display not later than one year after the date of receiving the
18	plaque.
19	(4) The department shall distribute the plaques to the qualifying schools no later than
20	January 1, 2028.
21	SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
22	ated to the Oregon Business Development Department for deposit into the Education Seismic
