## Senate Bill 232

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the superintendent of OSP to make a section to help drug endangered children. The Act tells the superintendent of OSP to hire a director of the section. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.7).

Directs the Superintendent of State Police to establish a division for the purpose of identifying and implementing ways to better serve and protect drug endangered children. Directs the superintendent to appoint a director of the division.

- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 181A.010 to 181A.350.
  - <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Superintendent of State Police shall establish a division for the purpose of identifying and implementing ways to better serve and protect drug endangered children.
  - (2) The superintendent shall appoint a director of the division established under subsection (1) of this section to perform such duties as the superintendent prescribes.
