

# Senate Bill 232

Sponsored by Senators MANNING JR, ANDERSON; Senators CAMPOS, GIROD, PATTERSON, WEBER (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the superintendent of OSP to make a section to help drug endangered children. The Act tells the superintendent of OSP to hire a director of the section. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.7).

Directs the Superintendent of State Police to establish a division for the purpose of identifying and implementing ways to better serve and protect drug endangered children. Directs the superintendent to appoint a director of the division.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 181A.010 to**  
5 **181A.350.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) The Superintendent of State Police shall establish a division for the**  
7 **purpose of identifying and implementing ways to better serve and protect drug endangered**  
8 **children.**

9 **(2) The superintendent shall appoint a director of the division established under sub-**  
10 **section (1) of this section to perform such duties as the superintendent prescribes.**
