SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the SBPPPS to do a study. (Flesch Readability Score: 84.9).

Requires the State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision to study issues related to parole. Directs the board to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary no later than September 15, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision shall study issues

5 related to parole. The board shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245,

6 and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legisla-

7 tive Assembly related to the judiciary no later than September 15, 2026.

8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.

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
