

Senate Bill 282

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Health Care)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would tell the OHA to study environmental health. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.3).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study environmental health. Directs the authority to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the environment no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study environmental health. The au-**
5 **thority shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include rec-**
6 **ommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related**
7 **to the environment no later than September 15, 2026.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
