

Senate Bill 294

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Health Care)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Makes OHA do a study on emergency departments. Makes OHA give a report on its findings. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.2).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study emergency departments. Directs the authority to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to emergency departments.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study emergency departments. The authority shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care no later than September 15, 2026.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
