Senate Bill 301

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the State Marine Board to study boat safety. The Act tells the board to

make a report on the results of the study. (Flesch Readability Score: 86.2).

Requires the State Marine Board to study issues related to the safe operation of motorboats.

Directs the board to submit findings to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to boats.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. The State Marine Board shall study issues related to the safe operation of boats. The board shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2026.
- SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027. 8
