## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells ODE to do an audit of the tests given to kindergarteners. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.7).

[Digest: Directs ODE to study the state of education in this state. (Flesch Readability Score: 72.6)]

Requires the Department of Education to [study the adequacy of public education in this state for kindergarten through grade 12] conduct an audit of assessments administered to kindergarteners in public schools. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education not later than September 15, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to kindergarten through grade 12 education.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Department of Education shall conduct an audit of the assessments administered to kindergarteners in the public schools of this state. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2026.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
