

Senate Bill 351

Sponsored by Senator SMITH DB (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money for a program for taking certain fish. (Flesch Readability Score: 80.3).

Appropriates moneys to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife for the purpose of funding programs that award \$5 for each take of pikeminnow, if the take complies with wildlife laws.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the capture of pikeminnow; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the**
5 **biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000 for the**
6 **purpose of funding programs that award \$5 for each take of a pikeminnow, if the take com-**
7 **plies with the wildlife laws. This appropriation is available continuously until expended for**
8 **the purpose specified in this section.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
