

Senate Bill 356

Sponsored by Senator SMITH DB (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to the Invasive Species Council. The Act describes how the money must be used. (Flesch Readability Score: 80.2).

Appropriates moneys to the Invasive Species Council, out of the General Fund, for certain purposes.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Invasive Species Council; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Invasive Species Council, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the**
6 **General Fund, the amount of \$480,000, for the following purposes:**

7 (1) **\$80,000 for emergency purposes.**

8 (2) **\$100,000 for outreach and education.**

9 (3) **\$300,000 for the operation of the council.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
