Senate Bill 365

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the Attorney General to help someone whose wine grapes were hurt by

wildfire smoke. (Flesch Readability Score: 70.1).

Directs the Attorney General to assist a person in recovering damages from the federal government when smoke from a wildfire on federal lands causes damages to the person's wine grape growing.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to wildfire. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. When smoke from a wildfire on federal lands causes damages to a person 4 engaged in wine grape growing, as defined in ORS 576.850, the Attorney General shall take 5 all actions within the Attorney General's power to assist the person in recovering damages 6 7 from the federal government.
