

Senate Bill 402

Sponsored by Senator GIROD (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells DSP to have a certain amount of troopers by 2036. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.4).

Directs the Department of State Police to maintain a staffing level of at least 20 patrol troopers per 100,000 residents of this state, beginning on January 1, 2036.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to patrol trooper staffing levels for the Department of State Police.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Department of State Police shall maintain a patrol trooper staffing level of at least 20 patrol troopers per 100,000 residents of this state, based on population figures from the most recent federal decennial census.

SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2025 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2036.

(2) The Department of State Police may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary for the department to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by section 1 of this 2025 Act.
