## Senate Bill 402

Sponsored by Senator GIROD (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells DSP to have a certain amount of troopers by 2036. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.4).

Directs the Department of State Police to maintain a staffing level of at least 20 patrol troopers per 100,000 residents of this state, beginning on January 1, 2036.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to patrol trooper staffing levels for the Department of State Police. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. The Department of State Police shall maintain a patrol trooper staffing level 4 of at least 20 patrol troopers per 100,000 residents of this state, based on population figures 5 from the most recent federal decennial census. 6 SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2025 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2036. 7 8 (2) The Department of State Police may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary for the department to exercise, on and 9 10 after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions

and powers conferred on the department by section 1 of this 2025 Act.
