

Senate Bill 413

Sponsored by Senator GIROD (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act directs each board of a higher learning school to limit the number of nonresident students. The Act requires the limit to be no more than 35% of the total student population. The Act declares an emergency and becomes law when the Governor signs it. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.5).

Directs the governing board of public universities in this state to adopt a policy that limits the enrollment of students who have not established residency in this state to 35 percent of the total student population at that university.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to limitations on nonresident student enrollment at public universities; and declaring an

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. The governing board of a public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall adopt**
6 **a policy that limits the enrollment of students at that university who have not established**
7 **residency in this state to 35 percent of the total student population at that university.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act first applies to the 2026-2027 academic year.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
