SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives moneys to OHA for the Vaccine Access Program. (Flesch Readability Score: 72.6).

[Digest: The Act tells OHA to study vaccine financing. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.2).]

[Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study vaccine financing. Directs the authority to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health not later than September 15, 2026.]

[Sunsets on January 2, 2027.]

Appropriates moneys to the Oregon Health Authority from the General Fund for the Vaccine Access Program.

A BILL FOR AN ACT
Relating to vaccine financing.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,800,000, which shall be allocated as follows:

(1) \$5,000,000 for the purchase of vaccines through the authority's Vaccine Access Program; and

(2) \$1,800,000 for the operation of the Vaccine Access Program.
