

A-Engrossed Senate Bill 420

Ordered by the Senate March 24

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. Digest: The Act gives money to DELC for certain home visiting services. (Flesch Readability Score: 72.6).

Appropriates moneys to the Department of Early Learning and Care out of the General Fund to expand or sustain Healthy Families Oregon home visiting services.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to Healthy Families Oregon home visiting services.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Early Learning and Care, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,000,000, to expand or sustain Healthy Families Oregon home visiting services.
