

Senate Bill 443

Sponsored by Senator PATTERSON (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says to give some moneys to the HECC to give to OHSU to help a family medicine residency program. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.6).

Appropriates moneys to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to the Area Health Education Center program of Oregon Health and Science University for supporting the Oregon Academy of Family Physicians.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,**
6 **2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,500,000 for the purpose of carrying out the**
7 **provisions of section 1, chapter 574, Oregon Laws 2023.**
