SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 451

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 26 and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section: "(a)(A) 'Cervical cancer screening' means health care services or products provided to 3 an individual without apparent symptoms of an illness, injury or disease as recommended by 4 the United States Preventive Services Task Force as Grade A or B or as recommended by 5 the Health Resources and Services Administration's guidelines, for the purpose of detecting 6 7 the presence of cervical cancer or precancerous lesions. "(B) 'Cervical cancer screening' does not include services that occur primarily for the 8 9 treatment of diagnosed cervical cancer. 10 "(b)(A) 'Follow-up examination' means additional cervical cancer examinations used to 11 evaluate an abnormality seen or suspected by a cervical cancer screening. 12"(B) 'Follow-up examination' does not include services that occur primarily for the 13 treatment of diagnosed cervical cancer. "(2) Except as provided in ORS 742.008, a carrier offering a group health benefit plan or 14 15an individual health benefit plan in this state that reimburses the cost of cervical cancer screenings may not impose deductibles, coinsurance, copayments or other out-of-pocket 16 17 costs on the coverage of medically necessary: 18 "(a) Cervical cancer screenings; and "(b) Follow-up examinations, regardless of whether different samples from the prior 19

cervical cancer screening are used or the follow-up examination is performed on a different
date than the cervical cancer screening. Follow-up examinations include human
papillomavirus examinations with typing, cytology, dual stain or colposcopy with biopsy.".
