

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 451

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 26 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

3 **“(a)(A) ‘Cervical cancer screening’ means health care services or products provided to**  
4 **an individual without apparent symptoms of an illness, injury or disease as recommended by**  
5 **the United States Preventive Services Task Force as Grade A or B or as recommended by**  
6 **the Health Resources and Services Administration’s guidelines, for the purpose of detecting**  
7 **the presence of cervical cancer or precancerous lesions.**

8 **“(B) ‘Cervical cancer screening’ does not include services that occur primarily for the**  
9 **treatment of diagnosed cervical cancer.**

10 **“(b)(A) ‘Follow-up examination’ means additional cervical cancer examinations used to**  
11 **evaluate an abnormality seen or suspected by a cervical cancer screening.**

12 **“(B) ‘Follow-up examination’ does not include services that occur primarily for the**  
13 **treatment of diagnosed cervical cancer.**

14 **“(2) Except as provided in ORS 742.008, a carrier offering a group health benefit plan or**  
15 **an individual health benefit plan in this state that reimburses the cost of cervical cancer**  
16 **screenings may not impose deductibles, coinsurance, copayments or other out-of-pocket**  
17 **costs on the coverage of medically necessary:**

18 **“(a) Cervical cancer screenings; and**

19 **“(b) Follow-up examinations, regardless of whether different samples from the prior**  
20 **cervical cancer screening are used or the follow-up examination is performed on a different**  
21 **date than the cervical cancer screening. Follow-up examinations include human**  
22 **papillomavirus examinations with typing, cytology, dual stain or colposcopy with biopsy.”.**

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
