

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 473**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 21 through 26 and insert:

2 “(b)(A) ‘Public official’ means a person who is elected or appointed or who has filed the required
3 documents for nomination or election to an office established, and the qualifications and duties of
4 which are prescribed, by statute or the Oregon Constitution to perform a public duty for the state
5 or any political subdivision of the state.

6 “(B) ‘Public official’ includes an assistant or deputy district attorney, a person serving as a
7 prosecutor for a city or county, an assistant attorney general, an administrative law judge and a
8 judge serving upon appointment as a senior judge or a judge pro tempore.”.
