## Senate Bill 480

Sponsored by Senator MEEK (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells a state agency to study point of sale systems. (Flesch Readability Score: 78.2). Requires the Department of Consumer and Business Services to study contract terms for point of sale systems. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to commerce not later than September 15, 2026. Sunsets January 2, 2027.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to contract terms for point of sale systems.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall study contract terms for point of sale systems. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to commerce no later than September 15, 2026.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
