SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act adds two members to the Building Codes Structures Board. (Flesch Readability Score: 87.9). [Digest: The Act tells OHCS to study housing. (Flesch Readability Score: 90.9).]

[Requires the Housing and Community Services Department to study housing and to report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to housing by September 15, 2026.]

Adds two members to the Building Codes Structures Board and adds two professions that the board members must represent.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 455.132 is amended to read:
5	455.132. (1) There is established in the Department of Consumer and Business Services a Build-
6	ing Codes Structures Board consisting of [nine] 11 members.
7	(2) The Building Codes Structures Board shall assist the Director of the Department of Con-
8	sumer and Business Services in administering the structural, prefabricated structures and energy
9	programs described in this chapter and the accessibility to persons with physical disabilities pro-
10	gram described in ORS 447.210 to 447.280.
11	(3) The board shall consist of members broadly representative of the industries and professions
12	involved in the development and construction of buildings and energy conservation, including:
13	(a) An architect [or engineer];
14	(b) A general contractor, as defined in ORS 701.005, specializing in the construction of buildings
15	more than three stories above grade;
16	(c) A contractor specializing in construction for heavy industry;
17	(d) A representative of the building trade;
18	(e) A representative of a utility or energy supplier;
19	(f) A representative of a fire protection agency;
20	(g) A building official;
21	(h) An owner or manager of a commercial office building; [and]
22	(i) A representative selected from individuals recommended by the Oregon Disabilities
23	Commission[.];
24	(j) A fire protection engineer; and
