## Senate Bill 5

Sponsored by Senator ANDERSON

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act directs higher learning schools to have a policy that requires certain teachers to have obtained at least a master's degree. The Act provides for exceptions. (Flesch Readability Score: 64.6).

Requires the governing board of each public university in this state to adopt a personnel policy that includes institutional standards for faculty qualifications. Requires that the standards include that faculty must have obtained at least a master's degree. Provides for exceptions to the policy.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to faculty qualifications for public universities.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The governing board of each public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall

5 establish a personnel policy that includes institutional standards for instructor qualifications.

6 The policy established under this subsection must require that faculty of lower division

7 collegiate courses have obtained at least a master's degree in a subject area closely related

8 to any course the faculty will be teaching.

9 (2) The policy established under subsection (1) of this section may provide for an excep-10 tion to the master's degree requirement for:

(a) Faculty who have a demonstrated competency in a professional field closely related
to any course the faculty will be teaching.

(b) Graduate students who are enrolled at the public university and are employed by the
public university to teach.

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
