## Senate Bill 510

Sponsored by Senator SMITH DB (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Makes the PUC do a study on the rate impacts from the required reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and submit a report. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.4).

Requires the Public Utility Commission to study the rate impacts associated with implementing the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions required by House Bill 2021 (2021). Directs the commission to submit its findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to energy no later than September 15, 2026.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to utility rate impacts.

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- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. The Public Utility Commission shall study the rate impacts associated with

(ORS 469A.400 to 469A.475). The commission shall submit a report in the manner provided

- 5 implementing the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions required by House Bill 2021 (2021)
- by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees
- of the Legislative Assembly related to energy no later than September 15, 2026.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
