SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to an agency for an inspection program. The program relates to small-scale meat processing and sales. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.5). Appropriates moneys to the State Department of Agriculture for purposes related to a program

Appropriates moneys to the State Department of Agriculture for purposes related to a program of state inspection for the processing and sale of meat products from nonamenable species.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) There is appropriated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the

6 biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, for hiring

7 up to the equivalent of two full-time staff members for the program of state inspection au-

- 8 thorized by ORS 619.042.
- 9 (2) The department shall ensure that the staff members described in subsection (1) of 10 this section undertake activities in an equitable manner across this state, prioritizing:
- 11 (a) Slaughter-specific facilities.
- 12 (b) Facilities in rural and underserved communities.

(c) Facilities that receive funding under the Oregon Meat Processing Infrastructure and
Capacity Building Grant Program.

15 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 16 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect 17 on its passage.
