## Senate Bill 544

Sponsored by Senator SOLLMAN (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act requires vaping detectors to be installed in certain high schools. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.7).

Requires vaporizing detection devices to be installed in certain areas of high schools that have 1,000 or more enrolled students.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the installation of vaporizing detection devices in high schools.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 **<u>SECTION 1.</u>** (1) As used in this section:

5 (a) "Inhalant" has the meaning given that term in ORS 433.835.

6 (b) "Vaporizing detection device" means a device capable of detecting vapor created from

7 an instrument used to vaporize an inhalant.

8 (2) Each school district shall:

9 (a) Ensure that a vaporizing detection device is installed in all student bathrooms and 10 common areas at each high school in the district that has a student enrollment that is 11 greater than 1,000.

(b) Establish written policies and rules regarding disciplinary action for students who
are, by means of a vaporizing detection device or otherwise, discovered to be vaporizing an
inhalant. A school district's policies and rules established under this paragraph may not in clude suspension or expulsion.
