Senate Bill 5503

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act approves agency fees. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.4). Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by the State Department of Agriculture. Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.
