2 are established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for pay-
3 ment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the state agencies listed, for
4 the acquisition of land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, fur-
5 nishing and equipping of buildings and facilities:

17 **“SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
18 \$449,447,853 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit
19 for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Re-
20 ceipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Higher
21 Education Coordinating Commission, for expenditures of proceeds from state bonds issued
22 for the benefit of a public university, pursuant to agreements between the commission and
23 a public university.

24 **“SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
25 \$20,000,000 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit
26 for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Re-
27 ceipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Higher
28 Education Coordinating Commission, for expenditures of proceeds from state bonds issued
29 for the benefit of a community college, pursuant to agreements between the commission and
30 a community college.

31 **“SECTION 5.** The project approvals and expenditure limitations in sections 1, 2, 3 and 4
32 of this 2025 Act and the expenditure limitations established by the Emergency Board during
33 the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for capital construction or acquisition projects, expire
34 on June 30, 2031, unless otherwise noted.

35 **“SECTION 6.** The expiration dates of the project approvals and expenditure limitations
