26 "<u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 27 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment 28 of expenses for operations, grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services by the De-29 partment of Early Learning and Care from corporate activity tax funds transferred from the 30 Early Learning Account by the Department of Education, for the following purposes:
