

# A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5530

Ordered by the Senate June 27  
Including Senate Amendments dated June 27

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act makes a budget for certain lottery moneys and for moneys in certain accounts. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).

Maintains and reserves lottery revenues available to benefit public purposes during the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, in the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund. Allocates moneys from the fund for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025.

Directs the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to establish a process for quarterly allocations of moneys from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund and the Veterans' Services Fund.

Allocates moneys from the Veterans' Services Fund for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025.

Directs the distribution of moneys from the Criminal Fine Account. **Directs the Department of Revenue to establish a process for the distributions.**

Directs the distribution of moneys from the Oregon Marijuana Account.

Directs the distribution of moneys from the Fund for Student Success.

Requires the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to transfer certain amounts from the Tobacco Settlement Funds Account for certain purposes.

Declares an emergency, effective *[July 1, 2025]* **on passage.**

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to state financial administration; creating new provisions; amending sections 24 and 25,  
3 chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. During the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, all lottery revenues available to**  
6 **benefit the public purposes specified in Article XV, section 4, of the Oregon Constitution,**  
7 **that are in excess of distributions or allocations required by law shall be maintained in the**  
8 **Administrative Services Economic Development Fund.**

9 **SECTION 2. All moneys in the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund as**  
10 **of July 1, 2025, and thereafter are reserved to meet the commitments of sections 1 to 13 of**  
11 **this 2025 Act.**

12 **SECTION 3. The following amounts are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025,**  
13 **from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Business De-**  
14 **velopment Department, for the following purposes:**

- 15 (1) **Operations..... \$ 20,346,833**
- 16 (2) **Business, innovation**
- 17 **and trade..... \$ 75,381,963**
- 18 (3) **Infrastructure..... \$ 5,872,354**
- 19 (4) **Oregon Film and Video**

2 **SECTION 4.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the Admin-  
3 istrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Department of Education, for the  
4 State School Fund, the amount of \$606,501,675.

5 **SECTION 5.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the Admin-  
6 istrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the office of the Governor, the amount  
7 of \$5,213,172 for expenses of the Regional Solutions Program.

8 **SECTION 6.** (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall establish a  
9 process for allocating available moneys in the Administrative Services Economic Develop-  
10 ment Fund on a quarterly basis to fulfill the biennial allocations made by sections 1 to 13 of  
11 this 2025 Act. The department shall set the quarterly allocations.

12 (2) If, in any quarter, the moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund to the Ad-  
13 ministrative Services Economic Development Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly  
14 allocations made by sections 1 to 13 of this 2025 Act or any other 2025 Act, prior to making  
15 any other allocations pursuant to sections 1 to 13 of this 2025 Act, the department shall  
16 satisfy lottery bond debt service obligations in the amount of \$389,965,797 for outstanding  
17 lottery bonds.

18 (3) After the lottery bond debt service obligations described in subsection (2) of this  
19 section are satisfied, if the remaining moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund to  
20 the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund are insufficient to pay for the  
21 quarterly allocations made by sections 1 to 13 of this 2025 Act, the department shall reduce  
22 the quarterly allocations not described in subsection (2) of this section proportionately in  
23 amounts sufficient to accommodate the revenue shortfall.

24 **SECTION 7.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the Admin-  
25 istrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Department of Administrative  
26 Services, the amount of \$389,965,797 for the purpose of paying, when due, the principal, in-  
27 terest and premium, if any, on outstanding lottery bonds, as described in section 6 of this  
28 2025 Act.

29 **SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 461.547 (1) for a  
30 percentage-based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, the amount  
31 allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Oregon De-  
32 partment of Administrative Services for distribution to counties for economic development  
33 activities as provided by ORS 461.547 is \$59,783,760.

34 **SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 461.549 (2) for a  
35 percentage-based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, the amount  
36 allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Problem  
37 Gambling Treatment Fund is \$18,853,152.

38 **SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 565.447 for a  
39 percentage-based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, the amount  
40 allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the County Fair  
41 Account established in ORS 565.445 is \$5,744,348.

42 **SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the allocation described in section 2 (3),  
43 chapter 2, Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure 99 (2016)), as amended by section 23, chapter  
44 57, Oregon Laws 2019, for a percentage-based transfer of moneys with an annual cap, for the  
45 biennium beginning July 1, 2025, the amount allocated from the Administrative Services

1 Economic Development Fund to the Outdoor School Education Fund is \$48,060,583.

2 **SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the requirement in ORS 461.543 (4) for a  
3 percentage-based transfer of moneys, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, the amount  
4 allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Sports Lot-  
5 tery Account is \$18,852,926.

6 **SECTION 13.** Notwithstanding section 44, chapter 355, Oregon Laws 2019, as amended by  
7 section 1, chapter 10, Oregon Laws 2021, no moneys are allocated from the Administrative  
8 Services Economic Development Fund to the Employer Incentive Fund for the biennium be-  
9 ginning July 1, 2025.

10 **SECTION 14.** There are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the  
11 Veterans' Services Fund, to the Veterans' Department of Veterans' Affairs Dedicated Lot-  
12 tery Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:

- 13 (1) Veterans' operations..... \$ 2,768,376
- 14 (2) Appeals and special advocacy ... \$ 2,168,419
- 15 (3) Strategic partnership..... \$ 15,249,233
- 16 (4) Aging veterans' services..... \$ 3,602,439

17 **SECTION 15.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the  
18 Veterans' Services Fund, to the Bureau of Labor and Industries, the amount of \$307,006 for  
19 veterans' employment apprenticeship outreach and coordination.

20 **SECTION 16.** There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the  
21 Veterans' Services Fund, to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, the amount of \$628,510  
22 for veterans' specialty courts.

23 **SECTION 17.** There are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the  
24 Veterans' Services Fund, to the Oregon Health Authority, the following amounts for the  
25 following purposes:

- 26 (1) Veterans' behavioral  
27 health services..... \$ 2,879,455
- 28 (2) Veterans' dental program..... \$ 3,519,334

29 **SECTION 18.** (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall establish a  
30 process for allocating available moneys in the Veterans' Services Fund on a quarterly basis  
31 to fulfill the biennial allocations made by sections 14 to 17 of this 2025 Act.

32 (2) If the moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund to the Veterans' Services  
33 Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly allocations under subsection (1) of this section,  
34 the department shall reduce the quarterly allocations proportionately in amounts sufficient  
35 to accommodate the revenue shortfall.

36 **SECTION 19.** (1) Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025,  
37 the Department of Revenue shall distribute the moneys in the Criminal Fine Account es-  
38 tablished by ORS 137.300 as specified in sections 20 to 24 of this 2025 Act.

39 (2) The Department of Revenue shall establish a process for distributing available moneys  
40 from the Criminal Fine Account on a monthly basis to fulfill the biennial distributions made  
41 by sections 20 to 24 of this 2025 Act.

42 (3) If the moneys from the Criminal Fine Account are insufficient to pay for the monthly  
43 distributions under subsection (1) of this section, the department shall reduce the monthly  
44 distributions proportionately in amounts sufficient to accommodate the revenue shortfall.

45 **SECTION 20.** There is allocated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and

1 Training for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the Criminal Fine Account, the  
2 amount of \$65,846,019 for the purpose of criminal justice training and standards operations.

3 **SECTION 21.** There are allocated to the Department of Justice for the biennium begin-  
4 ning July 1, 2025, from the Criminal Fine Account, the following amounts for the following  
5 purposes:

- 6 (1) Child Abuse Multidisciplinary  
7 Intervention Account..... \$ 14,289,302
- 8 (2) Creation and operation of a  
9 statewide system of regional  
10 assessment centers as  
11 provided under ORS 418.746  
12 to 418.796..... \$ 959,151

14 Compensation Account ..... \$ 10,704,460
- 15 (4) Services to children eligible

20 **SECTION 22.** There are allocated to the Department of Human Services for the biennium  
21 beginning July 1, 2025, from the Criminal Fine Account, the following amounts for the fol-  
22 lowing purposes:

24 established in ORS 409.300  
25 for the purpose of  
26 ORS 409.292 (1)(a) to (c)..... \$ 2,850,674
- 27 (2) Sexual Assault Victims Fund.... \$ 630,635

28 **SECTION 23.** There are allocated to the State Court Facilities and Security Account es-  
29 tablished under ORS 1.178, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the Criminal Fine  
30 Account, the following amounts for the following purposes:

- 31 (1) State court security  
32 and emergency preparedness.... \$ 5,087,487
- 33 (2) Distributions to county court  
34 facilities security accounts..... \$ 1,852,863

35 **SECTION 24.** There is allocated to the Department of Revenue for the biennium begin-  
36 ning July 1, 2025, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$159,700 for administrative  
37 costs of the department.

38 **SECTION 24a.** Notwithstanding section 26, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023, and ORS  
39 137.300, amounts deposited in the Criminal Fine Account in the biennium ending June 30,  
40 2025, may not be distributed to or deposited in the General Fund by operation of those  
41 sections of law.

42 **SECTION 24b.** Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, amounts deposited in the Criminal Fine  
43 Account in the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, may not be distributed to or deposited in the  
44 General Fund by operation of ORS 137.300.

45 **SECTION 25.** (1) There is allocated to the State School Fund established under ORS

1 327.008, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the  
2 amount of \$43,568,275.

3 (2) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for mental health treatment or for  
4 purposes related to alcohol and drug abuse prevention, early intervention and treatment  
5 services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the  
6 amount of \$21,784,137.

7 (3) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the health systems division,  
8 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount  
9 of \$5,446,034 for purposes related to alcohol and drug abuse prevention, early intervention  
10 and treatment services.

11 (4) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July  
12 1, 2025, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount of \$192,330,671, for deposit into the  
13 Drug Treatment and Recovery Services Fund.

14 (5) There is allocated to the State Police Account established under ORS 181A.020, for the  
15 biennium beginning July 1, 2025, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount of  
16 \$16,338,103.

17 **SECTION 26.** Notwithstanding and in lieu of the percentage-based transfers of moneys  
18 described in ORS 327.001 (4)(c), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, the Department of  
19 Education shall distribute the moneys in the Fund for Student Success established by ORS  
20 327.001 as follows:

21 (1) \$1,109,828,482 to the Student Investment Account established in ORS 327.175;

22 (2) \$559,443,881 to the Statewide Education Initiatives Account established in ORS 327.250;  
23 and

24 (3) \$550,384,601 to the Early Learning Account established in ORS 327.269.

25 **SECTION 27.** In addition to transfers to the Tobacco Enforcement Fund under ORS  
26 293.537, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall make the following trans-  
27 fers from the Tobacco Settlement Funds Account for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025:

9 **Sec. 25.** (1) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority for the biennium beginning July  
10 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$42,884 for the purpose of grants under ORS  
11 430.345 for the establishment, operation and maintenance of alcohol and drug abuse prevention,  
12 early intervention and treatment services provided through a county.

13 (2) There is allocated to the Law Enforcement Medical Liability Account established under ORS  
14 414.815, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of  
15 \$1,300,000.

16 (3) There is allocated to the Oregon State Police for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from  
17 the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$351,572 for the purpose of enforcing the laws relating  
18 to driving under the influence of intoxicants.

19 (4) There is allocated to the Department of Corrections for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023,  
20 from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$0 for the purpose of planning, operating and main-  
21 taining county juvenile and adult corrections programs and facilities and drug and alcohol programs.  
22 Notwithstanding ORS 137.300 (4), the grant to each county shall be based on the formula used to  
23 determine the distribution of moneys under the Grant-in-Aid Program under ORS 423.530.

24 (5) There is allocated to the State Court Technology Fund established under ORS 1.012, for the  
25 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of [~~\$2,927,500~~] **\$0**.

26 (6) There is allocated to the Intoxicated Driver Program Fund created under ORS 813.270, for  
27 the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$4,323,000.

28 (7) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023,  
29 from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$331,824 for the Emergency Medical Services and  
30 Trauma Systems Program created under ORS 431A.085.

31 (8) There is allocated to the Department of Revenue for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023,  
32 from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$100,000 for administrative costs of the department.

33 **SECTION 30.** **This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
34 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**  
35 **on its passage.**
