

Senate Bill 5532

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates agency budgets. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.4).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists and the Oregon Board of Psychology for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists and the Oregon Board of Psychology.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of specified boards; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Coun-**
5 **selors and Therapists, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the**
6 **amount of \$468,750.**

7 **SECTION 2. There is appropriated to the Oregon Board of Psychology, for the biennium**
8 **beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$156,250.**

9 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
10 **\$5,013,196 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for**
11 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
12 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Board of**
13 **Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists.**

14 **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
15 **\$2,179,721 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for**
16 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
17 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Board of**
18 **Psychology.**

19 **SECTION 5. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
20 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
21 **July 1, 2025.**
