## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act creates an agency budget. (Flesch Readability Score: 73.8).

[Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Department of State Lands for biennial expenses.]

Limits biennial expenditures from certain fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the [department] **Department of State Lands** for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by the department from specified continuously appropriated funds.

Limits certain biennial expenditures by the department from federal funds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

## 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Department of State Lands; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds, federal funds and funds described in sections 2 to 6 of this 2025 Act, collected or received by the Department of State Lands, for the following purposes:

- 14 Reserve operations...... \$ 4,039,329
- 15 (3) Elliott State Research Forest... \$ 12,086,084 16 (4) Capital improvements...... \$ 596,145

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$2,019,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of State Lands from the Portland Harbor Cleanup Fund established by ORS 274.064.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$213,600 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of

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expenses by the Department of State Lands from the Submerged Lands Enhancement Fund established by ORS 274.388.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$2,282,425 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of State Lands from the Oregon Removal-Fill Mitigation Fund established by ORS 196.640.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$250,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of State Lands from the Oregon Ocean Science Fund established by ORS 196.567.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$11,151,895 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of State Lands from the Oregon Abandoned and Derelict Vessel Fund established by ORS 274.371.

SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of State Lands for the following purposes:

- (1) South Slough National
- 20 Estuarine Research
- **Reserve operations...... \$ 4,325,973**
- 22 (2) Common School Fund
- **programs......\$ 116,945**

<u>SECTION 8.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expenditures by the Department of State Lands for tenant-incurred utility charges and State Treasurer charges for investment-related transactions are not limited.

SECTION 9. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.
