"SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$143,579,808 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Department of Transportation for debt service.

"SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$1,109,618 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Veterans' Services Fund established under ORS 406.140 to the Department of Veterans' Affairs and transferred to the Department of Transportation for veteran transit services.

"SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$19,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of Transportation from American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and transferred to the Department of Transportation, for the Newberg-Dundee Bypass Project.

"SECTION 7. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expenditures by the Department of Transportation from federal funds for debt service on Build America Bonds are not limited.

"SECTION 8. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, expenditures by the Department of Transportation from the Oregon Transportation Infrastructure Fund established under ORS 367.015 for debt service and for internally reimbursed expenditures are not limited.

"SECTION 9. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.".
