

# Senate Bill 56

Sponsored by Senator HAYDEN (at the request of Ben West, BSN, MSN, RN) (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Makes OHP and health insurance cover more services for heart issues. (Flesch Readability Score: 72.6).

Requires the state medical assistance program and health insurance policies and certificates to cover computerized tomography coronary calcium score scans.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to cardiac computerized tomography coronary calcium score scans.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414.**

5 **SECTION 2. The health services to be provided in medical assistance under ORS 414.065**  
6 **must include computerized tomography coronary calcium score scans with or without con-**  
7 **trast when prescribed by a licensed or certified health professional.**

8 **SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of the Insurance Code.**

9 **SECTION 4. (1) A policy or certificate of health insurance offered in this state that re-**  
10 **imburses the cost of laboratory services must reimburse the cost of computerized**  
11 **tomography coronary calcium score scans with or without contrast, when prescribed by a**  
12 **licensed or certified health professional.**

13 **(2) This section is exempt from ORS 743A.001.**

14 **SECTION 5. Section 4 of this 2025 Act applies to policies and certificates of health in-**  
15 **surance issued, renewed or extended on or after January 1, 2026.**
