

# Senate Bill 579

Sponsored by Senator FREDERICK (at the request of Chief Rob Bullock, Central Douglas Fire and Rescue) (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to the State Fire Marshal for distribution related to a fire station. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.6).

Appropriates moneys to the State Fire Marshal for distribution to Central Douglas Fire and Rescue for certain purposes.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to funding for fire stations; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the State Fire Marshal, for the biennium beginning**  
5 **July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$950,000 for distribution to Central**  
6 **Douglas Fire and Rescue for adding living quarters to the fire station in Umpqua.**

7 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
8 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**  
9 **on its passage.**
