

# Senate Bill 629

Sponsored by Senator BONHAM (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that the OMB has to look at a reasonable person standard when it says what unprofessional conduct is. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.6).

Requires the Oregon Medical Board to consider a reasonable person standard in determining what constitutes unprofessional conduct.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the Oregon Medical Board; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 677.417.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. ORS 677.417 is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 677.**

**SECTION 2.** ORS 677.417 is amended to read:

677.417. The Oregon Medical Board shall determine by rule what constitutes medical incompetence, unprofessional conduct, physical incapacity or impairment for the purposes of ORS chapter 677. **When determining what constitutes unprofessional conduct, the board shall consider a reasonable person standard.**

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
