Senate Bill 639

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the State Forester to manage state forests in a manner that keeps fuel load levels low. (Flesch Readability Score: 76.2).

Requires the State Forester to actively manage state forestlands to achieve and maintain low forest fuel load levels.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to low forest fuel load levels on state forestland. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. In managing state forestlands as described in ORS 530.050, the State Forester shall use active management designed to achieve and maintain low forest fuel load levels on the forestlands in order to promote forest health values and the control of wildfire risk.
