

# Senate Bill 665

Sponsored by Senator BONHAM (at the request of Senator Noah Robinson) (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that public bodies may not keep money from certain fines or civil penalties. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.9).

Requires public bodies to transfer moneys deriving from certain fines and civil penalties to the General Fund for general governmental purposes.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to monetary penalties.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other law, if a public body receives moneys that**  
5 **derive from the levy of a fine or civil penalty authorized under state law, the public body**  
6 **shall promptly transfer the entirety of such moneys to the State Treasurer for deposit in the**  
7 **General Fund for general governmental purposes.**

8 (2) As used in this section, "public body" has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.
