

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 692

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

June 19

On page 20 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 36, delete “\$\_\_\_\_\_” and insert “\$1,000,000”.

On page 21, after line 1, insert:

**“SECTION 25. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (1), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for Medicaid, is increased by \$1,851,146 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.**

**“SECTION 26. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (1), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for Medicaid, is increased by \$2,072,116 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.**

**“SECTION 27. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (6), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for central services, is increased by \$360,099 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.**

**“SECTION 28. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (8), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds received from charges, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for central services, is increased by \$31,510 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.**

**“SECTION 29. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 5 (6), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for central services, is increased by \$58,517 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14**

1 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8  
2 of this 2025 Act.

3 **“SECTION 30.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
4 ation made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (4), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025  
5 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for public health, is in-  
6 creased by \$407,812 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025  
7 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

8 **“SECTION 31.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
9 expenditures established by section 2 (5), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill  
10 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses  
11 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds  
12 received from charges, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section  
13 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received by the  
14 Oregon Health Authority, for public health, is increased by \$140,965 for carrying out the  
15 provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668  
16 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

17 **“SECTION 32.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
18 \$1,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for  
19 payment of expenses by the Oregon Health Authority for carrying out the provisions of sec-  
20 tion 1 of this 2025 Act, from the Community-Based Perinatal Services Access Fund estab-  
21 lished in section 2 of this 2025 Act.

22 **“SECTION 33.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
23 ation made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (3), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025  
24 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for health policy and an-  
25 alytics, is increased by \$158,308 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17  
26 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this  
27 2025 Act.

28 **“SECTION 34.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
29 expenditures established by section 5 (3), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill  
30 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses  
31 from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws  
32 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for  
33 health policy and analytics, is increased by \$27,940 for carrying out the provisions of sections  
34 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections  
35 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

36 **“SECTION 35.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
37 ation made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (7), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025  
38 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for state assessments and  
39 enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$23,312 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1,  
40 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7  
41 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

42 **“SECTION 36.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
43 expenditures established by section 2 (9), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill  
44 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses  
45 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds

1 received from charges, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section  
2 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received by the  
3 Oregon Health Authority, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by  
4 \$2,393 for carrying out the provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the  
5 amendments to ORS 414.668 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

6 “SECTION 37. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
7 expenditures established by section 5 (7), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill  
8 5025), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses  
9 from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws  
10 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 5025), collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for  
11 state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$13,330 for carrying out the  
12 provisions of sections 1, 10, 14 and 17 of this 2025 Act and the amendments to ORS 414.668  
13 and 414.669 by sections 7 and 8 of this 2025 Act.

14 “SECTION 38. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
15 ation made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (2), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws  
16 2025 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for state assess-  
17 ments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$33,627.

18 “SECTION 39. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
19 expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate  
20 Bill 5526), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-  
21 penses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare  
22 receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental  
23 Security Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery  
24 funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled  
25 Senate Bill 5526), collected or received by the Department of Human Services, for state as-  
26 sements and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$1,252.

27 “SECTION 40. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
28 expenditures established by section 3 (2), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate  
29 Bill 5526), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-  
30 penses from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon  
31 Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), collected or received by the Department of Human  
32 Services, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$31,034.

33 “SECTION 41. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
34 expenditures established by section 2 (8), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled Senate  
35 Bill 5526), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-  
36 penses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare  
37 receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental  
38 Security Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery  
39 funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled  
40 Senate Bill 5526), collected or received by the Department of Human Services, for shared  
41 services, is increased by \$94,870.”.

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
