SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act directs HECC to create a pilot program that gives money to student teachers. The Act sunsets on January 2, 2028. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.0).

Directs the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish a pilot program to provide stipends for student teachers and the educators who mentor student teachers for licensure. Sunsets on January 2, 2028.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to stipends for student teachers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall establish at least**
5 **one pilot program at a public or private institution of higher education in this state to pro-**
6 **vide stipends to student teachers and educators who mentor student teachers for licensure.**

7 **(2) Under the pilot program:**

8 **(a) The institution of higher education shall partner with one or more school districts in**
9 **this state to provide stipends to student teachers and educators who mentor student teach-**
10 **ers for licensure.**

11 **(b) Priority must be given to student teachers:**

12 **(A) From underrepresented backgrounds;**

13 **(B) Who work in a school district located in a rural area of this state; and**

14 **(C)(i) Who work in special education; or**

15 **(ii) Who work in science, technology, engineering and mathematics.**

16 **SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2028.**

17 **(2) Section 1 of this 2025 Act applies to the 2026-2027 school year.**
