Senate Bill 717

Sponsored by Senator GORSEK (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act directs HECC to create a pilot program that gives money to student teachers. The Act sunsets on January 2, 2028. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.0).

Directs the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish a pilot program to provide stipends for student teachers and the educators who mentor student teachers for licensure. Sunsets on January 2, 2028.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to stipends for student teachers.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall establish a pilot

5 program at a public university listed in ORS 352.002 to provide stipends to student teachers

6 and educators who mentor student teachers for licensure.

- 7 (2) Under the pilot program:
- 8 (a) The public university shall partner with one or more school districts in this state to

9 provide stipends to student teachers and educators who mentor student teachers for 10 licensure.

11 (b) Priority must be given to student teachers:

12 (A) From underrepresented backgrounds;

- 13 (B) Who work in a school district located in a rural area of this state; and
- 14 (C)(i) Who work in special education; or
- 15 (ii) Who work in science, technology, engineering and mathematics.
- 16 SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2028.
- 17 (2) Section 1 of this 2025 Act applies to the 2026-2027 school year.
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
