6 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 3 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 443.400 to 7 443.455.

8 "<u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) The Department of Human Services may not grant a residential care 9 facility's request for an exception to the requirements of ORS 443.400 to 443.455 or any other 10 statutory licensing requirements, unless expressly authorized by statute to grant an excep-11 tion or to temporarily modify a licensing requirement due to a declaration of a state of 12 emergency.

"(2) If the department, under authority granted by statute or established by rule, approves a request for an exception to a licensing requirement, other than a requirement described in subsection (1) of this section, the department shall notify the Long Term Care Ombudsman of the exception request and the department's intent to approve the request no fewer than seven days before the exception takes effect.
