

Senate Bill 765

Sponsored by Senator NASH, Representative LEVY B (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act allows the use of meat from certain nuisance game mammals. The Act allows a person to keep the meat or give it away, among other possible options. (Flesch Readability Score: 72.5).

Allows a person taking certain nuisance game mammals to offer the meat to a charitable organization, retain the meat or make any disposition authorized by rule.

2 Relating to the use of meat.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "charitable organization" and "game meat" have**
5 **the meanings given those terms in ORS 619.095.**

6 **(2) A person who takes an antelope, bighorn sheep, deer, elk, moose or mountain goat**
7 **under a permit described in ORS 498.012 may:**

8 **(a) Offer the game meat to a charitable organization;**

9 **(b) Retain the game meat for private, noncommercial use; or**

10 **(c) Make any disposition authorized by the State Fish and Wildlife Commission by rule.**
