## Senate Bill 778

Sponsored by Senator NASH, Representative LEVY B; Representative HARBICK (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells OHA to make changes to the rates for reimbursing air ambulance services. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.5).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organizations to provide reimbursement for air ambulance services provided to medical assistance recipients at rates in accordance with the national Ambulance Inflation Factor.

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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to reimbursement rates for air ambulance services.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414.

5 SECTION 2. (1) Every two years, the Oregon Health Authority shall recalculate and re-

6 vise the reimbursement rates in the medical assistance program for air ambulance services

7 in accordance with the national Ambulance Inflation Factor under section 1834(l)(3)(B) of the

8 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395m).

9 (2) A coordinated care organization shall provide reimbursement for air ambulance ser-10 vices at the rates established under subsection (1) of this section.

SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2025 Act applies to contracts between a coordinated care organization and the Oregon Health Authority entered into, amended or renewed on or after the effective date of this 2025 Act.

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
