

Senate Bill 790

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act makes a new name for the head of OACO. (Flesch Readability Score: 100).

Renames the position of Administrator of the Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office to executive director of the Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office; amending ORS 185.010.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 185.010 is amended to read:

5 185.010. (1) The Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office shall be staffed by an [*administrator*]
6 **executive director**, who is responsible for the performance of the duties, functions and powers of
7 the office.

8 (2) A board consisting of the chairpersons of the commissions served by the office and the
9 Governor shall establish the qualifications for and appoint the [*Administrator of the Oregon Advoca-*
10 *cacy Commissions Office*] **executive director**.

11 (3) The [*Administrator of the Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office*] **executive director** shall
12 receive a salary as prescribed by law, or as prescribed by the board described in subsection (2) of
13 this section if a salary is not prescribed by law.

14 (4) The [*Administrator of the Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office*] **executive director** is in the
15 unclassified service.

16 (5) The [*Administrator of the Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office*] **executive director** shall
17 provide each commission served by the office with the administrative support needed by the com-
18 mission to carry out the statutory duties of the commission. Subject to any applicable provisions
19 of the State Personnel Relations Law, the [*administrator*] **executive director** shall employ all per-
20 sons necessary for the operation of the office, prescribe the duties of those employees and establish
21 the compensation payable to those employees.
