SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: This Act tells the OCAC to study and make a report on natural climate solutions. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).

Requires the Oregon Climate Action Commission to study natural climate solutions. Directs the commission to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the environment no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to natural climate solutions.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. The Oregon Climate Action Commission shall study natural climate solutions. The commission shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the environment no later than September 15, 2026.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
