

# Senate Bill 812

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Governor Tina Kotek for State Department of Fish and Wildlife)

## SUMMARY

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the landowner preference program; repealing section 2, chapter 208, Oregon Laws 2021.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. Section 2, chapter 208, Oregon Laws 2021, is repealed.**
