CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management; amending ORS 401.052.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 401.052 is amended to read:

- 401.052. (1) The Oregon Department of Emergency Management is established.
- (2) The department shall be responsible for:
- (a) Coordinating and facilitating private sector and governmental efforts to prevent, prepare for, respond to and recover from emergencies; and
- (b) Coordinating exercises and training, planning, preparedness, response, mitigation and recovery activities with state and local emergency services agencies and organizations.
- (3) The department may purchase or contract for any materials, supplies or equipment, including motor vehicles, that the department deems necessary to carry out the duties of the department.
- [(3)] (4) The department shall prepare a statewide emergency management plan and update the plan from time to time as necessary.
